Waterloo Bridges Project – Historic Marker

January 21, 2025

Project Details

- Located adjacent to Park Avenue, near the amphitheater just south of the river wall.
- Improvements include mounted and restored beam section from original bridge on Park Avenue, paved viewing area and informational signing.
- State Historic Preservation Office requirements for mitigating removal of historic bridge.
- 60% plans completed in late November, 2024
- Final design completion anticipated Early Spring, 2025
- Construction to be completed in Late Fall, 2025
- Construction Estimate - \$172,000
