Update from the Sanitation Department.

Randy Bennett, Public Works Division Manager, provided an overview of the structure of the Sanitation Department. Scott Brunson, Sanitation Director, provided an overview of the Waterloo WYRE App and the improvements and benefits it provides.

Mr. Chiles questioned if the city would look to bring recycling in-house in the future.

Randy Bennett explained that the city is currently under contract with recycling services. However, before the contract expires, they can look at the pros, cons, and costs of a change.

Mr. Boesen questioned when the go back charges would begin.

Randy Bennett explained that it will take a while but hopefully by fall.

Mr. Boesen questioned how long the dumpster locking ordinance has been in effect.

Randy Bennett explained that, unfortunately, he was not aware it was in the ordinance until recently.

Mr. Nichols questioned how to report waste alongside the road.

Randy Bennett explained that citizens can use the app to report an issue.

Mr. Simon commented that, for example, what happens if someone reports a nuisance, like a chair sitting out in front of someone's house.

Randy Bennett explained that a clean-up like that would first go through code enforcement to give them a chance to rectify the problem.
