Updates from the Sanitation and Street Departments.

Matt Boquist and Daniel Greer, Street Department Directors, provided an overview of operations for the department.

Matt Boquist commented that there are two out of four operating.

Mr. Boesen questioned why this system has an issue with rock chips.

Matt Boquist commented that the DOT is using it on roadways that have higher speeds, so the gravel gets kicked off to the side, but where we are using it where drivers are going much slower, so the gravel stays on the road longer.

Mr. Boesen asked if the new equipment shown in the presentation needed to be trailered or is it roadworthy.

Matt Boquist commented it is roadworthy, but pilot cars are still used.

Mr. Simon commented that he receives calls about ruts that get put into people's yards.

Randy Bennett, Public Works Division Manager, shared that homeowners can utilize the compost site for fill dirt.
