Discussion of Lexipol software for the Police Department.

Chief Joe Leibold explained that the Police Department has numerous policies and every time a law change or court case comes out, the policies have to be updated in order to maintain compliance with current practices. He explained that it is incredibly difficult for the department to keep up with all of these changes. Lexipol is a software they are looking at purchasing that has a team of lawyers and risk managers that monitor law changes, case law, and best practices to immediately push out policy changes. When they push out changes, officers sign off that they have read the policy change.

Jeremy Sloan, Lexipol, provided an overview of the services provided by the software along with implementation costs and ongoing subscription costs.

Council members discussed Lexipol software with Chief Leibold.
